**Rebels grab 7th dartball title**

Larry Cummings of Messiah, and Duane Ottow of Atonement claimed Most Valuable Player honors. Cummings had 15 hits in 29 at-bats in the series for a .517 batting average, while Ottow went 17-for-38 for a .447 average.
